It Is A Question Of Faith

- How is the love of God manifested in the aging process?
 - I find myself in the role of David: loving the aged ones who did so much for me and wanting them to be rewarded in this world for their good deeds, rather than experience the pain and indignity of aging.
 - Wanting to prolong a relationship and present set of circumstances over which I do not have power.
 - Wanting to give them things they no longer want, use, or appreciate.
 - All the while, God has given them the moral instruction and both physical and spiritual desire to go home and wait for His call.

Honor

- Lev. 19:32 "You shall rise before the gray headed and honor the presence of an old man, and fear your God: I am the LORD."
- Job 32:4, 6 "Now because they were years older than he, Elihu had waited to speak to Job. 6 So Elihu, the son of Barachel the Buzite, answered and said: I am young in years, and you are very old; Therefore I was afraid, And dared not declare my opinion to you."

 - 1Chron. 29:28 "So he died in a good old age, full of days and riches and honor"
 - Prov. 23:22 "Listen to your father who begot you,
 And do not despise your mother when she is old."

- Wisdom
 - Job 12:12 "Wisdom is with aged men, And with length of days, understanding."
 - Job 32:7 "I said, Age should speak, And multitude of years should teach wisdom."

Wisdom

- 1Kings 12:6, 8, 13-14 - "Then King Rehoboam consulted the elders who stood before his father Solomon while he still lived, and he said, How do you advise me to answer these people? ... 8 But he rejected the advice which the elders had given him, and consulted the young men who had grown up with him, who stood before him... 13 Then the king answered the people roughly, and rejected the advice which the elders had given him; 14 and he spoke to them according to the advice of the young men, saying, My father made your yoke heavy, but I will add to your yoke; my father chastised you with whips, but I will chastise you with scourges!"

- Isa. 46:4 "Even to your old age, I am He, And even to gray hairs I will carry you! I have made, and I will bear; Even I will carry, and will deliver you."
- Psalm 71:9, 17-18 "Do not cast me off in the time of old age; Do not forsake me when my strength fails... 17 O God, You have taught me from my youth; And to this day I declare Your wondrous works. 18 Now also when I am old and gray headed, O God, do not forsake me, Until I declare Your strength to this generation, Your power to everyone who is to come."

Strength


- Deut. 33:25 "As your days, so shall your strength be."
